

OREGON STATE BASKETBALL ALL-AMERICANS

STEVE JOHNSON 1977-81



- Consensus All-American in 1981.
 - Pac-10 Player of the Year in 1981.
 - Three-time All-Pac-10 selection.
 - 1981 first round draft pick of the Kansas City Kings.
 - His .678 field goal percentage ranks second all-time in the NCAA and is a Pac-10 record.
 - Led the NCAA for single season field goal percentage in 1980 (.710) and 1981 (.746).
 - His .746 field goal percentage in 1981 is an NCAA record.
 - His .710 field goal percentage in 1980 is fourth all-time in NCAA.
 - Holds Pac-10 record for single game field goal percentage by going 13-for-13 Dec. 5, 1979 at Hawaii-Hilo.
 - Led the Pac-10 in scoring as a senior with a 21.0 average.
 - Led the Pac-10 for field goal percentage all four years, and his redshirt season of 1978, teammate Bill McShane led the conference.
- Ranks fifth in the Pac-10 for career field goals with 828 and eighth in points with 2,035.
 - Shares OSU record with Jose Ortiz for consecutive field goals made (16).
 - Shares OSU record for blocked shots in one game with six vs. Wyoming Nov. 27, 1978 and Gonzaga Dec. 16, 1978.
 - Ranks second as OSU for career points with 2,035.
 - Second at OSU for career-field goals with 828.
 - OSU jersey retired during 1996-97 season.
 - Scored a career-high 38 points vs. BYU Dec 28, 1979 and vs. Washington Jan. 24, 1981.

FREDDIE BOYD 1970-72



- 1972 All-American
- NBA career included the Jazz and 76ers.
- 1972 First Round (5th pick) by Philadelphia 76ers.
- At the time of his graduation, he was the fourth-leading scorer in OSU history with 1,221 points.
- 10th for career assists with 362 points.
- All-Pac-8 Conference selection as a senior.
- OSU Team MVP in 1971 and '72.

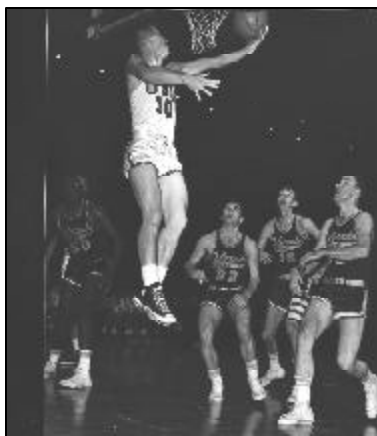
